#### REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING

Attorney Edison stated that the Division of Water has not done anything concerning Bullitt Utilities sewer treatment plant. He stated his understanding is that all adjoining plants are at full capacity. He says it could be a year before a permanent solution is reached.

Mayor Parker introduced Tom Reber who had sent the City an email about his concerns over the situation with the sewer treatment plant, He is not a resident of the City, but a resident of the County. He stated he had spoken to Bullitt County Fiscal Court recently, about his concerns and asked for assistance from Fiscal Court. The only response he received was that the plant is a privately owned package plant and the County would have no control over the situation. He stated he would like to see accountable leadership in the County.

Attorney Edison stated there still had not been a response concerning the airport pumping station, and he felt they would not do anything about the situation.

Mr. Edison stated he had talked with Brad Armstrong who is working with Kandie Adkinson at the state level, on resolving the boundaries.

Mark Edsion gave the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of Ordinance #2014-03, setting the budget for fiscal year 2014-2015. Caprice Price made a motion to accept Ordinance #2014-03 as read. Phillip Price 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Mark Edison gave the 1<sup>st</sup> reading of Ordinance #2014-04, Parking of Motor Vehicles. There was some discussion as to parking on sidewalks. The Commission will review and discuss at the next meeting.

## **New Business**

Mayor Parker called for any new business.

Commissioner Phillip Price presented the Commission with photos of sidewalks that need to be repaired in the City. Mayor Parker stated she would get bids on the sidewalk.

Caprice Price made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Phillip Price 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
