There will be a hearing on January 27, 2015 at 9 am. Attorney Edison stated he will be intervening for the City of Hillview and would do the same if so directed by the City of Hunters Hollow. Mayor Parker and the Commission authorize Attorney Edison to intervene on behalf of the City of Hunters Hollow. Mayor Parker states she intends on attending the hearing. She stated at previous meetings in Frankfort, she was told they would try and keep a surcharge as low as possible, hopefully under \$20.00.

Mayor Parker reported no work had been done on the ditch behind her home. The agreement was that the work would be completed in 75 days. If the work is not completed, Mr. Edison stated he would go back to court and ask that BCSD be held in contempt of court if the work is not complete per the contract.

New Business

Mayor Parker reported that a white Ford Fusion was parking at the intersection of Arcadia and Angelina. She will have Officer Wheeler find out who owns the car and notify them they cannot park there.

Bonnie Israel made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Caprice Price 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
