Attorney Edison reported that the PSC hearing took place on March 31, 2015. Mayor Parker reported testimony was given for several hours. Testimony was given that many of the sewer lines in the streets in Hunters Hollow were in very bad condition. Any decisions by the PSC to be made will be forthcoming in the weeks ahead.

BCSD was given an extention until May 1, 2015 to complete the ditch work behind the Mayor's home. To date no work had been completed.

All street signs had been replaced. Flashing light near the Material Handling Plant had also been installed.

New Business

Attorney Edison informed the Council that the legislature changed the statute allowing for Real Property taxes to be paid in installments if the entity so allowed. After a short discussion it was decided we would not allow installment payments on taxes. The legislature also rewrote the formula for determining the amount of Municipal Aid Road Funds distributed. Therefore the City will need to take that into consideration when doing the budget for 2015/2016.

Mayor Parker stated the budget meeting would take place on May 3, 2015 at 1pm at the clerk's home.

Caprice Price made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Phillip Price 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
