AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 985-XIII, THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEARS JULY 1, 1983, THROUGH JUNE 30, 1985.

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of April, 1985, the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow did adopt Ordinance No. 985-XIII, An Ordinance Adopting City of Hunters Hollow, Kentucky, Annual Budget for the Fiscal Years July 1, 1983, through June 30, 1985, and:

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend said budget to reflect accurately the revenues received and the expenditures made, now, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

Section 1. The annual budget for the Fiscal Years beginning July 1, 1983, and ending June 30, 1985, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION THREE: Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be published according to law.

SECTION FIVE: This Ordinance shall become effective upon first reading and publication. An emergency exists in that the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 1985, will terminate prior to this Ordinance's passage by normal procedure. Therefore, there will be no budget under which the City of Hillview can expend the necessary funds for its operation.
