

ORDINANCE NO. 985-XX

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 985-XV, THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1985, THROUGH JUNE 30, 1986.

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of April, 1985, the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow did adopt Ordinance No. 985-XV, an Ordinance Adopting City of Hunters Hollow, Kentucky, Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year, July 1, 1985, through June 30, 1986, and:

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend said budget to reflect accurately the revenues received and the expenditures made, now, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

Section 1. The annual budget for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 1985 and ending June 30, 1986, is hereby amended to read as follows:
