

ORDINANCE NO. 985-42

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING PERSONAL PROPERTY AD VALOREM TAXES AND PROVIDING FOR ASSESSMENT, EQUALIZATION AND COLLECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH KRS 92.280, et seq.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION I: That a personal property ad valorem tax of 0.05 on each \$100.00 of value of all personal property taxable for municipal purposes except property assessed by the State in said City is hereby levied for the year 1988, as of January 1, 1988.

SECTION II: Said levy is made for the purpose of raising revenue to pay salaries of officers and employees, for the repair and maintenance of streets and public ways and public buildings in said City, to pay for lighting city streets and to pay all proper charges and legal demands against the City.

SECTION III: That the assessment made by the Bullitt County Tax Commissioner for state and county purposes for 1988 shall be and is hereby adopted as the assessment for City purposes. These taxes as they relate to motor vehicles shall be collected by the Bullitt County Court Clerk as provided by KRS 132.487 et seq.

SECTION IV: That the City Clerk be and she is hereby directed to forward to the Department of Property Valuation, 592 East Main Street, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601, a 1988 Motor Vehicle Tax Rate Certification for the year 1988.

SECTION V: City Clerk is directed to advertise the above as provided by law.

SECTION VI: All payments of taxes provided for herein shall be received by the City Clerk/Treasurer at the business offices of City of Hunters Hollow, 11300 Angelina Road, Louisville, Bullitt County, Kentucky 40229.

SECTION VII: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance to be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION VIII: Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Given first reading at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 16th day of August, 1988. Given second reading, voted upon and passed at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 20th day of September, 1988.
