

ORDINANCE NO. 985-61

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALORM TAXES ON PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANIES AS OF JANUARY 1, 1991.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION ONE: An ad valorem tax of 19.2 cents on each \$100.00 of value of all property in said City, of public service companies taxable for municipal purposes which are assessed by the Department of Revenue, is hereby levied for the year 1991 as of January 1, 1991.

SECTION TWO: Said levy is made for the purpose of raising revenue to pay salaries of officers and employees; for repair and maintenance of streets, public ways, and public buildings in said city; to pay for lighting of city streets; and to pay all proper charges and legal demands against the city.

SECTION THREE: The provisions of Ordinance No. 985-59 as to the method of collection and enforcement shall apply to the tax levied herein.

SECTION FOUR: The Clerk is directed to advertise this Ordinance as provided by law.

SECTION FIVE: All payments of taxes provided for herein shall be made to the City Clerk/Treasurer at the business offices of the City of Hunters Hollow, 11300 Angelina Road, Louisville, Kentucky 40229.

SECTION SIX: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph or part of this Ordinance to be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance.

SECTION SEVEN: Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Given first reading at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 20th day of August, 1991. Given second reading, voted upon and passed at the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Bullitt County, Kentucky, the 17th day of September, 1991.
