ORDINANCE NO. 985-84

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF HUNTERS HOLLOW, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow has considered the evidence of the Public Hearing held by the Planning Commission and the recommendation of the Planning Commission; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow has conducted a public hearing and considered the public comments received in its decision concerning this proposed text amendment, now, therefore

The City Council of the City of Hunters Hollow, Kentucky does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 9.400 Schedule of Fees, Charges & Expenses is amended as follows:

LATE FEE & PENALTY FEE:

In addition to the regular building permit fee established herein, there shall be a LATE FEE, assessed by the Administrative Official, for obtaining a building permit or compliance permit after contruction has commenced of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) minimum plus an additional Penalty Fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per day for each day, after the first day contruction has commenced, on which addition contruction activity occurs without a building permit or compliance permit being issued with the total sum of these Late Fees and Penalty Fees not the exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

SECTION TWO: Section 2.200 Words and Terms Defined is amended by adding the following:

Construction: The delivery, to the site, of materials which are to be incorporated into subsequent improvements which are lcoated on the site. This may include but is not limited to; concrete, lumber, brick, steel, block/brick or other similar material.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication.

SECTION FOUR: Should any section clause, line, paragraph or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not effect the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
