MINUTES REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING JUNE 16, ²⁰²⁰~~2019~~ 7PM

In Attendance: Mayor Ross, Clerk McCauley, Attorney Edison, Commissioners: Israel, Lotze and MacIntyre

Quorum determined and meeting called to order at 7 pm by Mayor Ross

Commissioner Lotze made a motion to accept the regular meeting minutes with corrections from May 19, 2020. Commissioner MacIntyre 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Commissioner Lotze made a motion to accept the financial report for May 31, 2020. Commissioner Israel 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

- Attorney Edison read the 2nd reading of Ordinance 2020-01 Budget FY 2020-2021. Commissioner MacIntyre inquired about MHS taxes for 2019. Attorney Edison explained that due to the new building of MHS in Mt Washington the taxes were inadvertently sent to Mt Washington instead of Hunters Hollow. Attorney Edison contacted the PVA office and there are in process of fixing taxes for 2020 and recouping lost taxes from 2019. Commissioner MacIntyre made a motion to accept Ordinance 2020-01 Budget FY 2020-2021. Commissioner Lotze 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

- Attorney Edison read the three delinquent taxes for sale. Commissioner MacIntyre was the only bidder for delinquent properties, therefore purchasing all three for \$441.21.



COUNCIL BUSINESS

- Mayor Ross received a complaint about the ditch line between Arbor Trace and Angelina Road to be mowed. Commissioner MacIntyre suggests getting a bid from Marty Hester to mow ditch line. The City will send courtesy letter to residents explaining it is the responsibility of the homeowner to keep ditch line clear.
- Commissioner MacIntyre said he would look at the mower to see if we can fix it to use or sell.

- Absent no report.




ADJOURNMENT

 Commissioner Lotze made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner MacIntyre 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.


