- ⬇ Attorney Edison read Resolution 2022-01 Adopt KIPDA Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan. Commissioner Israel made a motion to adopt Resolution 2022-01 KIPDA Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan. Commissioner Lotze 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion Carried.
- ⬇ Premium pay for the clerks will be paid quarterly at \$6.25 per hour for 10 hours per week until 2026. Commissioner MacIntyre made a motion to accept the premium pay for the clerks. Commissioner Lotze 2nd the motion. Vote was 2 in favor with Israel against. Motion Carried.
- ⬇ Attorney Edison read 1st reading of Ordinance 2022-01 Amend Budget FY2021-2022 to add ARPA Funds.
- ⬇ Attorney Edison had a few calls to his office concerning the rate increase for MSD. MSD will gradually increase rates over the next few years. MSD assumed all debt from Bullitt County Sanitation.
- ⬇ There were five delinquent properties for 2021 with three owners. The 1st certified mailings were sent out February 4, 2022.




ADJOURNMENT
