- ♣ Clerk Steele read Special meeting minutes from August 30, 2021. Commissioner MacIntyre made a motion to accept the Special meeting minutes as read. Commissioner Lotze 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
- Lotz Clerk Steele read the meeting minutes from September 21, 2021. Commissioner MacIntyre made a motion to accept the regular minutes as read. Commissioner MacIntyre-2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
- Clerk Steele read the financial report from September 31, 2021. Commissioner MacIntyre made a motion to accept the financial report from September 31, 2021. Commissioner Israel 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

- Louisville Paving Bill for Hillview Blvd was originally estimated at \$18,500 actual numbers were \$19889.50.

- ➡ Discuss a possible interlocal agreement with MSD and the City of Hunters Hollow. No interlocal agreement is needed with MSD. The City could address their drainage issues in the City. All ARPA projects must be committed by 2024 and spent by 2026.
- Ms. Parker is upset about sewage in yard. Attorney Edison said that the only way to solve the problem is to address the collapsed main. Commissioner MacIntyre suggested to do a study in the city to see what issues needs to be addressed in the City.
- ♣ Joe Wells from Zoneton Fire District asked for a donation for candy for Halloween. In 2020 Hunters Hollow gave \$200.00. Commissioner Israel made a motion to donate \$200.00 to Zoneton Fire for candy. Commissioner MacIntyre 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

- Mayor Ross asked if the council wants to stay with Hillview or Bid out for snow removal.

- Commissioner Israel asked about trimming the limbs in common area. As of the meeting date Hesters Lawn Service has not done any work as of yet.
- Commissioner Israel also asked about the 31W fence. Attorney Edison said the fence is not on the City's property.
